

Enjoy ! Discover the summer in Paris Ile-de-France

The summer festivals guide for Paris Ile-de-France has just come out.

From June to September, Paris Ile-de-France rocks to the rhythm of countless events that bring it to life: concerts, catwalk shows, balls, theatre, parades, opera, etc. There are so many festive rendezvous to help you discover – and rediscover – a tourist destination that is ever more creative and bustling.

From major classical music festivals and open air parties to circus spectaculars, each event is described and presented, with details of the line ups as well as practical information (entrance fees, access, etc). The main festivals are presented in special articles: Rock en Seine, Paris quartier d’été, les fêtes de Versailles, the festivities in the Nord-Est Parisien, and many more.

The *Enjoy !* guide has a print run of 150 000 copies in French and 50 000 in English, as well as a German version that can be downloaded from the web site.
